

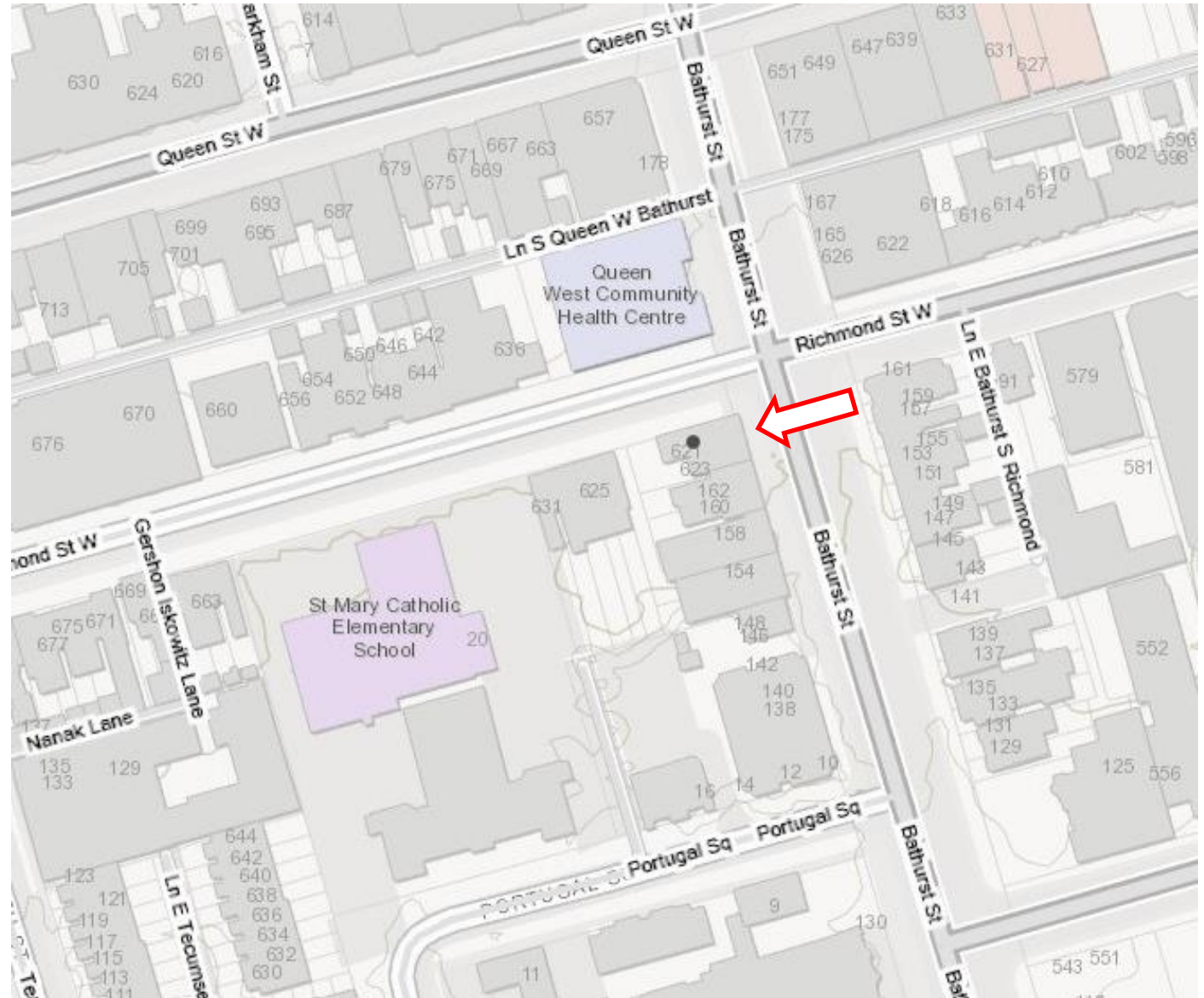

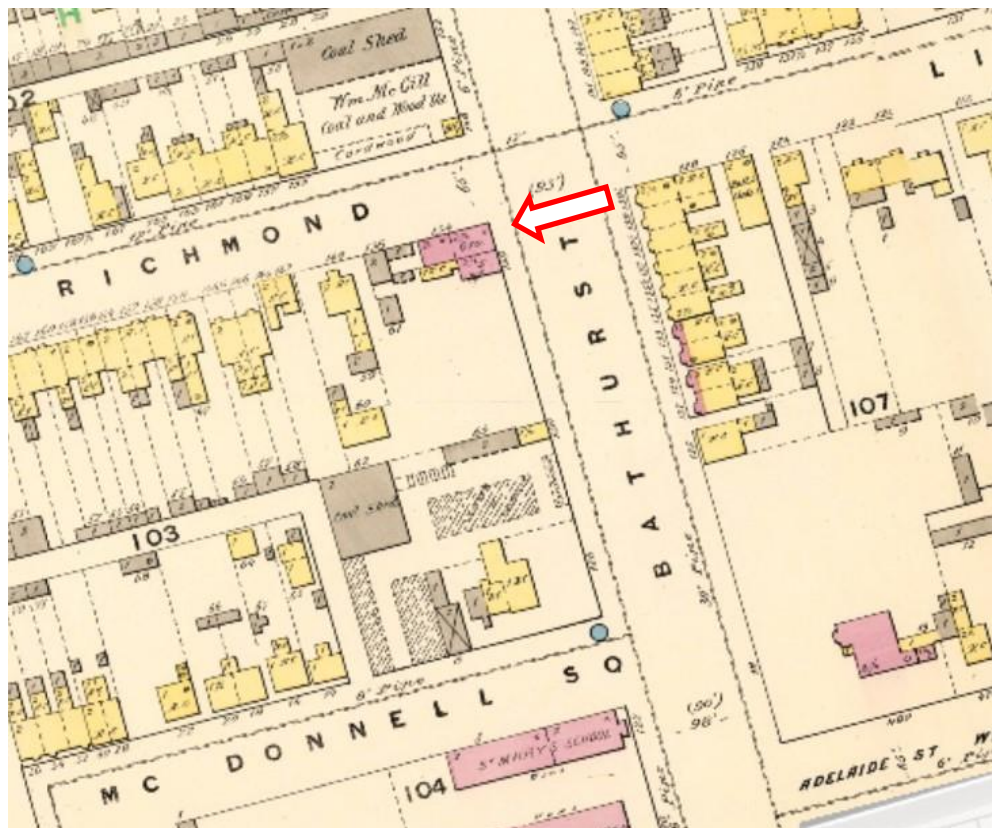
164 Bathurst Street; westward view of the building's east elevation along Bathurst Street. (Heritage Planning, 2021)

BATHURST ST. PROPERTY SOLD
A motion was made before Justice Rose in chambers at Osgoode Hall yesterday for an order approving of the sale of premises at 164 and 166 Bathurst St. and 621 Richmond St. W. to Annie Hofflazer for \$13,000. The property is owned by the estate of the late Bridget Hayes, who died in 1901. The property on the west side of Bathurst St. is described in the will as hotel property. Approval was granted.
