





The one storey school house was constructed in 1859 to the design of Jeseph Sheard.


Associated with hotel use

An addition was constructed in 1869 to the design of William Irving. This added two classrooms and two galleries to the building.

The property is altered for use as the Cherry Street Hotel. David Roberts Jr. is the architect associated with the third floor addition and corner portion of the building. A turret above the roof line has since been removed.

A three-storey warehouse was constructed in the late 1920s, with no architect of record. The warehouse was occupied by various manufacturers until the 1960s.











