RE: Agenda Item: PH 23.15 Toronto Building Process Review - Planning and Housing Committee Meeting - May 20, 2021

The Building Industry and Land Development Association is receipt of the City's Staff report for the Toronto Building Process Review and we would like to take this opportunity to provide you with the following comments. We acknowledge that the report is to provide a summary of the results of the review and present a new operating model to support the Division's transformation to a modern, customer-focused building regulator.

On behalf of our builder and renovator members, BILD would like to express its' support for the principles and actions outlined in this staff report. For background, this initiative was a main objective of BILD's CBO Renovator Roundtable, led by the City's Chief Building Official, senior staff, and a core group of BILD renovators. BILD renovator and builder members have continuously advocated for greater efficiencies and improved service delivery in systems and operations related to Toronto Building, and proactively approached your Chief Building Official requesting to be a part of solution-oriented discussions.
