Dear Chair Bailão and Council Members of the Planning and Housing Committee ("PHC"),

We are the land use planning consultants for the operators of <u>Heritage Funeral Centre - O'Connor Bros.</u>

<u>& Ralph Day Chapels</u>, a funeral home and visitation centre at the address municipally-known as 50 Overlea Boulevard in the City of Toronto, which lands are owned by 2041430 Ontario Inc.

50 Overlea Boulevard is zoned as "EO 2.0 (e.0.75; o2.0)(x21)" in By-law 569-2013 which zoning contains an exception that permits a funeral establishment (defined as "funeral home"), and is designated in the Toronto Official Plan as "General Employment Area".

The property immediately to the east of 50 Overlea Boulevard, those being 100 Thorncliffe Park Drive, is specifically proposed to be amended to remove certain land uses considered as sensitive land uses. The land use permissions in Section 8.4 Business Centre Zone – BC, Section 8.4.3 Exceptions, exception b) of the "BC-(2)" Business Centre zoning of the lands in the Former City of East York Leaside By-law 1916, are proposed to be amended to remove land use permissions for a Private and Public Recreational facility that is a Fitness Centre.

The zoning conformity exercise provides the City the opportunity to amend the employment zones to remove incompatible sensitive land uses, as proposed by Staff, to bring the By-law into conformity with the uses contemplated in the General and Core Employment Land Use Designations in the Official Plan.

<u>Heritage Funeral Centre - O'Connor Bros. & Ralph Day Chapels</u> wishes to be engaged when Phase 2 of the proposed zoning framework is underway and requests that the City provide <u>C2 Planning</u> and Heritage <u>Funeral Centre - O'Connor Bros. & Ralph Day Chapels</u> notice of any future meeting, reports, decisions or consultations regarding this matter.
