Pay-and-Display Parking - Kingston Road (Non-Delegated)

To: Scarborough Community Council

SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Kingston Road, City Council approval of this report is required.

Transportation Services and the Toronto Parking Authority (TPA) are requesting approval for the installation of on-street paid parking on Kingston Road in Ward 20.

The TPA has worked with Transportation Services to identify new pay-and-display parking spaces in Ward 20 that will compliment the operation of municipal Car Park 701 and support the local community and area businesses by encouraging a regular turnover in the on-street parking supply. Through this review, Transportation Services is recommending the introduction of pay-and-display parking on both sides of Kingston Road, between Victoria Park Avenue and Fallingbrook Road.

The proposed parking changes on Kingston Road will replace the existing unpaid, anytime parking that is currently in effect. The proposed changes will not impact the flow of traffic and will encourage parking turnover.

While this report seeks Community Council approval for the installation in Ward 20, this is an ongoing initiative, and Transportation Services and TPA will continue to review and report on potential new on-street paid parking opportunities throughout the City of Toronto.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council authorize the amendments to parking regulations required to establish new on-street paid parking locations, as set out in Attachments 2 and 3, to the report dated September 23, 2021 from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds for this work are included in the 2021 TPA Operating Budget GL Account # 66000010. All costs associated with the necessary signage installation are included within Transportation Services 2021 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

There is no prior decision history associated with this report.

COMMENTS

TPA has worked with Transportation Services to identify new pay-and-display parking spaces in Ward 20 that will compliment the operation of municipal Car Park 701 located at 197 Blantyre Avenue and support the local community and area businesses by encouraging a regular turnover in the on-street parking supply. Through this review, Transportation Services is recommending the introduction of pay-and-display parking on both sides of Kingston Road, between Victoria Park Avenue and Fallingbrook Road.

On-street parking spaces are typically the most convenient in serving areas of high demand, including local business areas. The on-street parking supply is meant to serve a short-stay need (considered less than 3 hours), which is reinforced by parking rates that encourage a turnover in the on-street parking supply so that it is available to as many users as possible.

Transportation Services and TPA have reviewed the parking regulations on Kingston Road within Ward 20 and have identified locations that would benefit from the introduction of on-street paid parking to better serve area demands and accommodate the maximum number of users. Currently, the proposed locations have regulations that allow for parking anytime:

Ward 20, Scarborough Southwest

- North side of Kingston Road, between Victoria Park Avenue and approximately 130 metres east of Fallingbrook Road - 44 spaces
- South side of Kingston Road, between Victoria Park Avenue and Courcelette Road -11 spaces

The proposed amendments will result in approximately 55 new on-street paid parking spaces.

The Ward Councillor has been consulted about the recommendation contained in this staff report.


