

Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking - Jolly Way

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking be introduced on Jolly Way, south of Ellesmere Road, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., as part of newly created Permit Parking Area 22A.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Jolly Way to accommodate their long-term parking needs.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council authorize parking by permit only on an area basis, within permit parking area 22A, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the odd side of Jolly Way, south of Ellesmere Road.
2. Scarborough Community Council authorize no parking at all times on the even side of Jolly Way (west branch), south of Ellesmere Road (west intersection) and Jolly Way (south branch).
3. Scarborough Community Council authorize no parking at all times on the even side of Jolly Way (south branch), between Jolly Way (west branch) and Jolly Way (east branch); and

4. Scarborough Community Council authorize no parking at all times on the even side of Jolly Way (east branch), south of Ellesmere Road (east intersection) and Jolly Way (south branch).

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated funding to implement permit parking is \$1,200 which is available within Transportation Services 2021 Operating Budget. The maximum annual revenue that could potentially be generated if all parking spaces are occupied by a permit holder is \$9,500.00.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Jolly Way, south of Ellesmere Road, to accommodate their long-term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Toronto Police Service, Parking Enforcement Unit.

Existing Conditions

Jolly Way is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east-west and north-south local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.7 metres
- There is no TTC service.

The parking regulations on Jolly Way, within the subject section are as follows:

North side

- Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

South side

- Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

West side

- Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

East side

- Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

A map of the area is included in Attachment 1.

Polling Results

In accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 925, a poll was conducted to determine if there is support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking. Ballots were mailed out on August 12, 2021 to all residents on Jolly Way with the last day for filing a response being September 10, 2021. A poll will be considered valid when at least 25 percent of the ballots mailed have been returned to the City Clerk. In order for a poll to be deemed positive, 50 percent plus one of returned ballots must be in favour of the request. For Jolly Way 46 ballots were returned which represents a response rate of 38 percent. Table 1 summarizes the level of support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking.

Table 1: Poll Results - Support for Permit Parking - Jolly Way

Response Type	Number of ballots	Percentage
In Favour	40	86%
Opposed	3	7%
Spoiled Ballot	3	7%

As the majority of the ballots returned were in favour of implementing permit parking and the required minimum response rate was met, the poll was deemed to be positive.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.

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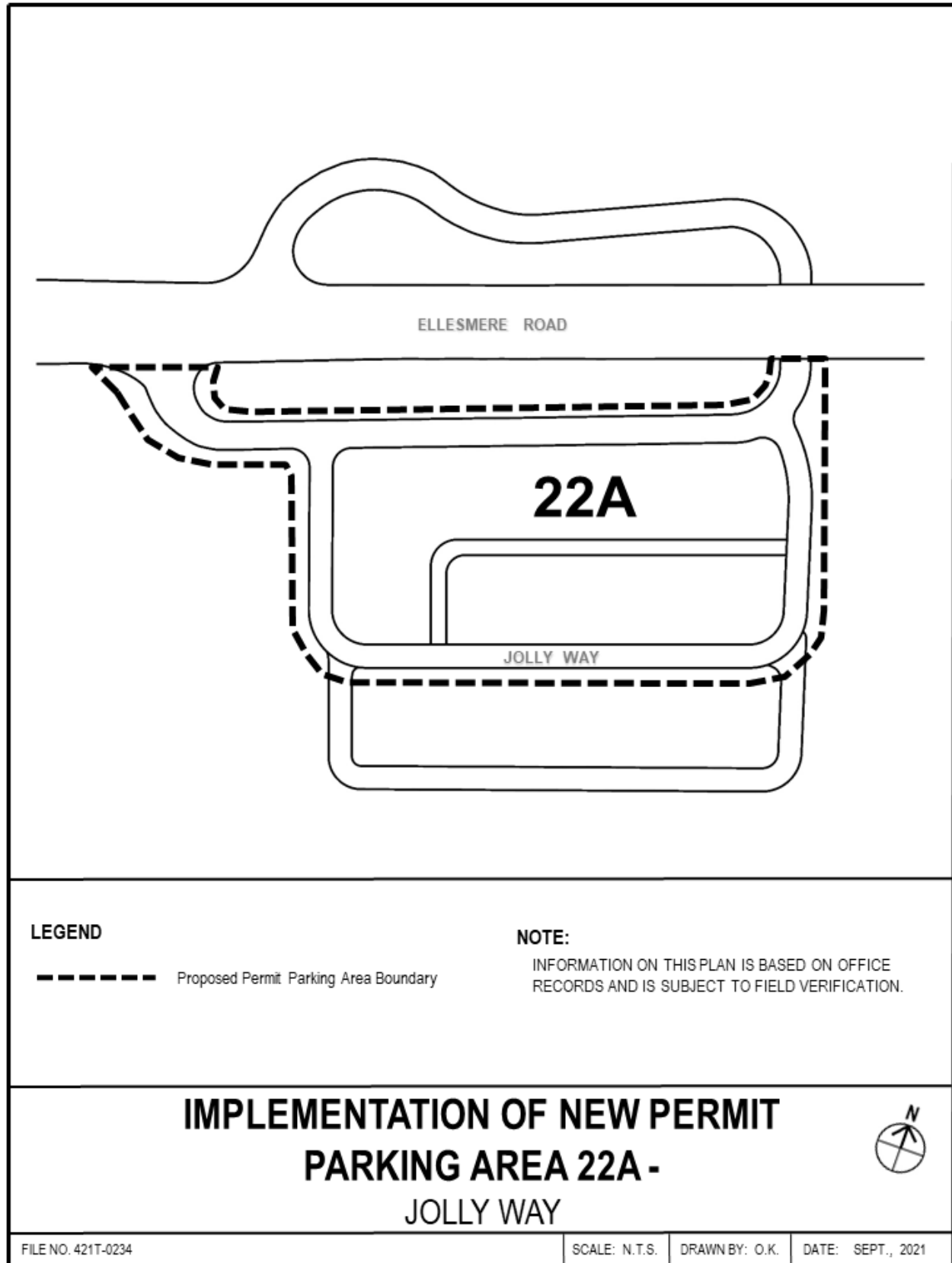


Figure 1-Location Map Jolly Way
