

Compulsory Stop Control - Cranston Manor Court and Senator Boulevard

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services recommends stop control for the minor street at the uncontrolled three-way intersection of Cranston Manor Court and Senator Boulevard in order to clearly define the right-of-way and to regulate traffic flow.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council authorize compulsory stop control for northbound traffic on Cranston Manor Court at Senator Boulevard.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed installation of the stop sign is approximately \$250.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2021 Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

As a result of an operational review, Transportation Services staff identified an uncontrolled three-way intersection at Cranston Manor Court and Senator Boulevard.

Existing Conditions

The following characteristics describe Cranston Manor Court and Senator Boulevard:

- The uncontrolled three-way intersection is located north of Kingston Road, east of Scarborough Golf Club Road
- There are no sidewalks located on both streets
- The land use in this area is single family residential dwellings

A minor street stop sign is recommended at the uncontrolled three-way "T" type intersection. This will provide stop sign uniformity on the streets in this area, clearly define the right-of-way, and enhance driver and pedestrian safety.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation of this staff report.
