In the interest of public safety of our children and community members I am requesting that Council consider adding a Pedestrian Crosswalk on Morrish Road. On behalf of The Highland Creek Community Association (HCCA) we believe this installation would be beneficial to not only the school aged children but to all the residents of the community. We believe a proactive approach to this issue instead of a reactive one often applied after an incident.

The HCCA has a history of advocating on behalf of our community. We believe many school aged children would benefit from this very important public safety initiative. We also have an aging population within the community with many senior citizens and blended families having to cross the street unsafely at any given time of the day. Given the demographics, the Pedestrian Crossover would be beneficial to the entire community at large.

The HCCA acknowledges concerns from current and former Principals and staff at Cardinal Leger Catholic School, as well as numerous parents and members of the community. We believe that action needs to be taken as quickly as possible in the interest of safety, as community members have been asking for this installation for far too long.
