

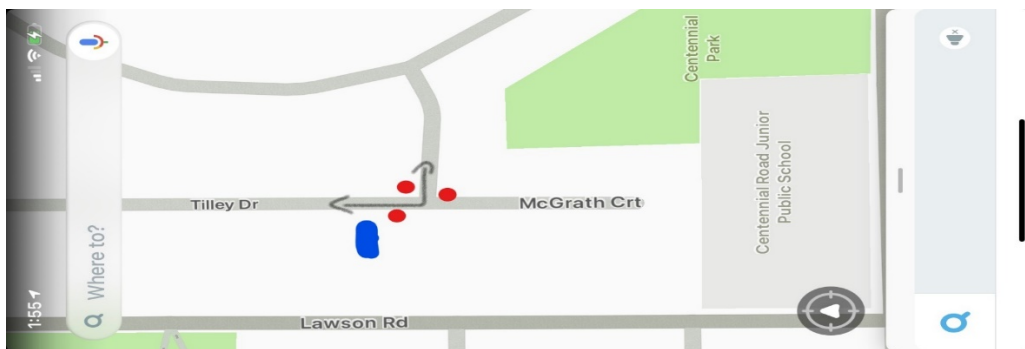


To Scarborough Community Council,

The Centennial Community and Recreation Association strongly advocates to ensure safety for children and residents in our Centennial community. There are 2 specific critical changes in the community that need immediate action:

1. 3-way STOP where Tilley Drive meets McGrath Court.
2. Clear, highly visible directional sign be placed on westbound Tilley Drive to indicate to drivers that Tilley Drive continues southbound (a left turn) before the intersection with McGrath Court starts.



The CCRA is aware that residents living on McGrath Court have been fighting for this 3-way stop for several years. In 2015 CityTV News broadcast a news piece about this dangerous intersection. Six years later, residents are still demanding action from the City to improve safety.

As an active community association which speaks on behalf of concerned residents, we recognize that children playing in and around the court area of McGrath Court are at risk of being hit by speeding drivers. The signage is confusing. Drivers travelling along Tilley Drive with intention to continue on Tilley are often taken by surprise by driving straight into McGrath Court which is a dead end. There is no STOP sign where Tilley turns south and the street signs are small and not noticeable.

The increase in home deliveries, uber drivers and taxi drivers, all who drive in a big rush, has greatly increased the risk to children and pedestrians.

Thank you for supporting these important safety measures in our community. We trust that City Council will approve, fund and install these critical measures as soon as all possible.
