Dear Members of Scarborough Community Council,

I write to you today in support of residents living in City of Toronto Neighbourhood #133, Centennial Scarborough, who have expressed their growing concern about pedestrian and motorist safety at the intersection of Tilley Drive and McGrath Court.

Residents feel as though community safety would be greatly enhanced if the presently uncontrolled intersection at Tilley Drive and McGrath Court were modified to become an all-way intersection following the installation of two stop signs: one for those traveling eastbound on Tilley Drive at McGrath Court, and one for those traveling westbound on Tilley Drive at McGrath Court.

As the Member of Parliament for Scarborough – Rouge Park, I echo the concerns of Centennial Scarborough residents, and hope that you will look favourably upon their request to increase pedestrian and motorist safety with the installation of these two stop signs.
