

Unaudited Financial Reports for Year-to-Date Q2 and Q3 2021

SUMMARY

The unaudited financial results for six months ended June 30, 2021 (Q2) and nine months ended September 30, 2021 (Q3) are provided in Attachments 1 and 2.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

COMMENTS

Actual year-to-date results are summarized below. This report covers Q2 and Q3 unaudited results as presented in Attachments 1 and 2.

Investment revenue in Q2 was very strong due to performance the equities portfolio and despite foreign currency losses on US\$ investment due to the appreciating CDN\$. Q3 earnings were positive and above budget year-to-date (YTD) budget by \$3M despite a market decline in late Q3, which was counterbalanced somewhat by US\$ appreciation against the CDN\$ resulting in unrealized gains from TAF's US holdings. YTD net earnings were \$3.99M in Q2 and \$3.85 YTD in Q3.

External revenues for Q2 and Q3 have consistently been below budget as decisions have been deferred due to COVID; several are now expected in 2022.

Program expenses were under budget in both quarters and Q3 YTD by \$1.4M. Q3 program expenses were \$200K higher than Q2 as retrofit activities gained momentum. Note that program spending is adjusted to match the external revenues received and expectations for the rest of the year; note that most external revenue is from government sources and is only received once expenditures have been made.

Grants payments amounted to \$500K in Q3 resulting in a small variance of \$25K above YTD budget. Grants are expected to be on-budget for the year based on the recommendations presented for Board approval at the November Board meeting. Grants are 35% of total expenditures.

Corporate Expenses for Q2 and Q3 were under budget YTD. Planned IT and software upgrades are expected to bring this line in on budget by year end.

No new funding agreements were signed during Q2 or Q3 2021.
