SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to appoint directors to the Bloor West Village, Leslieville, Riverside District, Roncesvalles Village and Wychwood Heights BIA boards of management and remove directors from the Chinatown, Leslieville, and Riverside District BIA boards of management.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The General Manager, Economic Development and Culture recommends that Toronto and East York Community Council:

1. In accordance with the City's Public Appointments Policy, appoint the following nominees to the Business Improvement Area (BIA) boards of management set out below at the pleasure of Toronto and East York Community Council, and for a term expiring at the end of the term of Council or as soon thereafter as successors are appointed:

Bloor West Village: MacKenzie, Renee

Leslieville: Meighen, Max Sinopoli, John Riverside District: Deutsch, Derek Griffin, Allison Sideris, Diana Wadhawan, Rohit

Roncesvalles Village: Berry, Ian Buzio, Guillermina

Wychwood Heights Saenz, Maria

2. Remove the following directors from the Business Improvement Area (BIA) boards of management set out below:

Chinatown: Huong, Sonny Rong, Jieneng

Leslieville: Kelly, Tracy Marvin, Conner Mamourian, Ara

Riverside District: Kennedy, Dianna

3. Direct that Schedule A of the Municipal Code Chapter 19, Business Improvement Areas, be amended by changing the number of directors of the following Boards of Management:

Leslieville	13
Riverside District	15

COMMENTS

From time to time, it is necessary to remove BIA board of management directors who are no longer able to serve, add new directors to fill vacant positions, and revise the size of BIA boards, as set out in Chapter 19 of the Toronto Municipal Code.

Bloor West Village

The appointment of one (1) director to the Bloor West Village BIA board of management will decrease the number of vacancies from one (1) to zero (0). Quorum will remain at three (3).

Chinatown

The removal of two (2) directors from the Chinatown BIA board of management will increase the number of vacancies from zero (0) to two (2). Quorum will decrease from nine (9) to eight (8).

Leslieville

At its Annual General Meeting of November 2, 2020, the membership of the Leslieville BIA voted to increase the size of the Leslieville BIA board of management from eleven (11) to thirteen (13). The addition of two (2) new positions, appointment of two (2) directors, and removal of three (3) directors will increase the number of vacancies from two (2) to five (5). Quorum will remain at three (3).

Riverside District

At its Annual General Meeting of November 4, 2020, the membership of the Riverside District BIA voted to increase the size of the Riverside District BIA board of management from eleven (11) to fifteen (15). The addition of four (4) new positions, appointment of four (4) directors, and removal of one (1) director will increase the number of vacancies from one (1) to two (2). Quorum will increase from four (4) to five (5).

Roncesvalles Village

The appointment of two (2) directors to the Roncesvalles Village BIA board of management will decrease the number of vacancies from three (3) to one (1). Quorum will increase from three (3) to four (4).

Wychwood Heights

The appointment of one (1) director to the Wychwood Heights BIA board of management will decrease the number of vacancies from two (2) to one (1). Quorum will remain at three (3).
