Dear Chair and Members of Toronto and East York Community Council,

Re: Speed Limit Reduction - Clinton Street, between College Street and Harbord Street

This item is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended.

Clinton Street, between College Street and Harbord Street is classified as a collector roadway, and generally operates one-way northbound, except for a small section between College Street and a point 107 metres north which operates two-way. This section of Harbord Street has traffic calming and has a posted speed limit of 30 km/h.

After a further review by Transportation Services staff, it was noted that there is an inconsistency with the bylawed, and posted speed limit, on this section of Clinton Street given the existing traffic calming measures. This by-law inconsistency will be resolved by the adoption of the recommendation noted below.

Recommendations:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council reduce the speed limit from 40 km/h to 30 km/h on Clinton Street, between College Street and Harbord Street.
