

Realignment of Permit Parking Area 5A to exclude the development located at 500 Dupont Avenue

SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Dupont Avenue, City Council approval of this report is required.

The purpose of this report is to respond to Toronto and East York Community Council's direction to review and report back on the realignment of Permit Parking Area 5A to exclude the development located at 500 Dupont Avenue.

Staff have determined the realignment of the Permit Parking Area 5A is feasible and has no objections to excluding the development at 500 Dupont Avenue.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council approve the amendment to Schedule B of the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 925, Permit Parking, to incorporate a revised map of permit parking area "5A", as shown in Attachment 1 of the report dated March 16, 2021 from the Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There is no financial impact associated with this report.

DECISION HISTORY

At its meeting of February 24, 2021 Toronto and East York Community Council adopted item TE23.84, and in so doing, requested Transportation Services to examine and report back to Toronto and East York Community Council regarding the realignment of Permit Parking Area 5A and the exclusion of the development address of 500 Dupont Avenue.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor on behalf of local residents to realign Permit Parking Area 5A, to exclude the development located at 500 Dupont Avenue.

Permit Parking Area 5A is bounded by Christie Street to the west, Bathurst Street to the east, Bloor Street West to the south, and Holland Park Avenue and Dupont Street and Hammond Place to the north. Area 5A has 1049 on-street parking spaces. To date 774 permits have been issued. This area does not have a history of being waitlisted, meaning the demand for overnight on-street parking permits has never exceeded the supply of parking spaces.

There is TTC service on Dupont Street.

A map of the area is included in Attachment 1.

A Public Notice was placed on the City's website requesting those objecting to the exclusion of 500 Dupont Street from Permit Parking in Area 5A forward their objections in writing to the City Clerk, so they may be scheduled as deputations at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting.

Transportation Services has no objections to the exclusion of 500 Dupont Street from Permit Parking in Area 5A.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.
