Reduction of Permit Parking Hours - Day Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking hours be reduced on Day Avenue, between Rogers Road and Bloem Avenue, from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Day Avenue, to improve parking flexibility for residents and their guests

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Day Avenue, between Rogers Road and Bloem Avenue from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated funding to extend permit parking hours is \$150 which is available within Transportation Services 2021 Operating Budget.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to reduce the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Day Avenue, between Rogers Road and Bloem Avenue.

Existing Conditions

The Day Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, north-south local roadway
- It operates two-way on a pavement width of approximately 7.3 metres
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street.
- There is no TTC service.

The parking regulations on Day Avenue, within the subject section are as follows:

East Side

- Currently signed as, overnight on-street permit parking from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.,
 7 days a week
- Maximum three-hour parking at all other times

West Side

No parking anytime

A map of the area is included in Attachment 1.

A Public Notice was placed on the City's website requesting those objecting to the reduction of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Day Avenue, between Rogers Road and Bloem Avenue forward their objections in writing to the City Clerk, so they may be scheduled as deputations at the Toronto and East York Community Council meeting

Transportation Services has no objections to the reduction of permit parking hours on Day Avenue, between Rogers Road and Bloem Avenue.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.
