Dear Chair and Members,

RE: Speed Hump Installation on Brock Avenue

BACKGROUND:

In the summer/fall 2020, residents reached out to my office with an urgent concern about speeding along their street and requested via a community-led petition that traffic calming measures (speed humps) be installed as a method of addressing these concerns. Unanimously, the residents surveyed were in support of making this change.

I am requesting that speed humps be installed on Brock Avenue from Croatia Street to Bloor Street West.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Toronto and East York Community Council waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Brock Avenue from Croatia Street to Bloor Street West; and
- Direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter sections of the roadway on Brock Avenue, for traffic calming purposes, generally as shown on the copy of Drawing No. 421G-3922, dated August 2021, from the Acting Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.
