

## **Extension of Permit Parking Hours - Fisken Avenue**

**To:** Toronto and East York Community Council

### **SUMMARY**

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This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking hours be extended on Fisken Avenue, between St John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week.

Residents requested the extension of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Fisken Avenue to improve parking flexibility, and to allow the Parking Enforcement Unit and Toronto Police Service to effectively control long term parking by non-residents through tagging and towing operations.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the extension of the overnight on-street permit parking hours on the odd side of Fisken Avenue, between St John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week to the new hours of 12:01 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., 7 days a week and;
2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the amendment of the one-hour maximum parking limit on the odd side of Fisken Avenue, between St. John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days a week and;

3. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize a one-hour maximum parking limit on the odd side of Fiskin Avenue, between St. John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days a week.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

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The estimated funding to extend permit parking hours is \$400 which is available within Transportation Services 2021 Operating Budget.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

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This report addresses a new initiative.

## **COMMENTS**

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A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to extend the overnight on-street permit parking hours on Fiskin Avenue, between St John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West, to improve parking flexibility and to allow the Parking Enforcement Unit, Toronto Police Service, to effectively control long term parking by non-residents through tagging and towing operations.

### **Existing Conditions**

Fiskin Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a one-lane, eastbound local roadway
- It operates two way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 7.3 metres
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street.
- There is no TTC service.

The parking regulations on Fiskin Avenue, within the subject section are as follows:

#### **West Side**

- No Parking anytime

#### **East Side**

- Overnight on-street permit parking from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., 7 days a week
- Maximum one-hour parking between 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., 7 days a week
- Maximum three-hour parking at all other times

A map of the area is included in Attachment 1.

Transportation Services has no objections to the extension of permit parking on Fiskin Avenue, between St John's Road and a point 45.7 metres south of Dundas Street West.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.

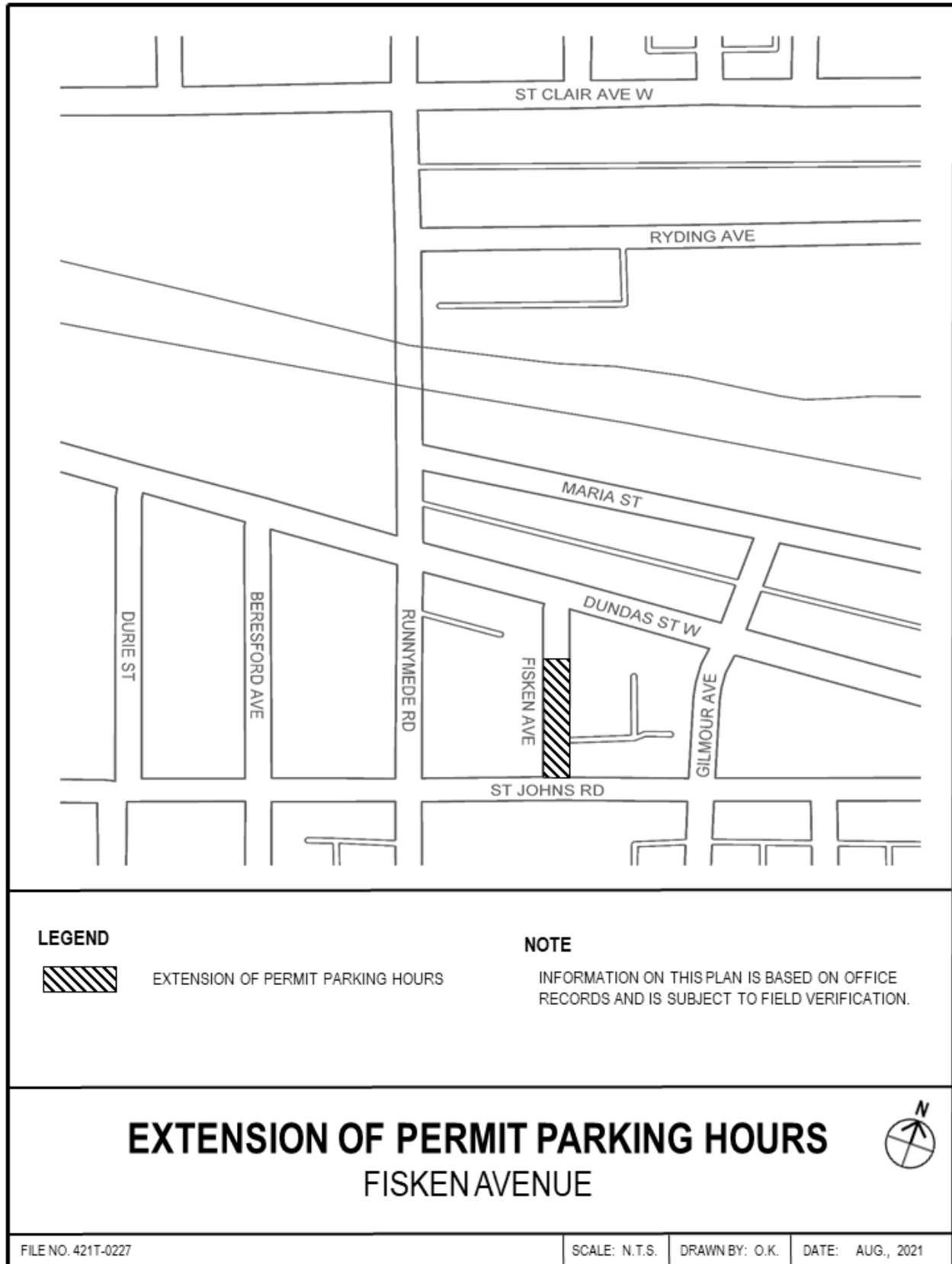


Figure 1: Location Map - Fisken Avenue
