Bloomfield and Greenwood Traffic Safety

Dear Chair and Members of Toronto and East York Community Council,

Residents of Bloomfield Avenue have been in touch with my office regarding concerns about traffic making dangerous turns from Greenwood onto Bloomfield. A petition has been submitted to my office requesting measures to slow down cars as they make the turn onto Bloomfield.

One block south, at Greenwood and Sandford, temporary curb extensions have helped slow down cars making high speed turns and provided some additional protection to pedestrians. With traffic beginning to return to pre-pandemic levels I am asking for your support for this request.

Recommendation:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the Director, Traffic Management to implement temporary curb extensions at Bloomfield and Greenwood and report to the February 16th meeting of Toronto and East York Community Council on whether it has been completed.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the Director, Traffic Management to consider other measures to slow down traffic on Bloomfield Avenue and include consideration of such measures in their report to the February 16th meeting of TEYCC.
3. Toronto and East York Community Council direct the Director, Traffic Management to include in their report to the February 16th meeting, analysis on the efficacy of the temporary curb extensions as a measure to improve traffic safety and include other potential options that could offer greater safety improvements
