**Re.: TE24.11 - King Parliament Secondary Plan Review
Final Report, Secondary Plan and Zoning By-Law Amendments**

West Don Lands Committee urges Toronto and East York Community Council to adopt the King Parliament Secondary Plan, Official Plan Amendment and the Zoning By-Law Amendments set out in the above-noted staff report and to authorize City Staff to implement this decision.

City Planning staff have presented twice to meetings of the West Don Lands Committee and have been well received by our members. Staff have responded thoroughly to us, explaining the implications of the proposed Secondary Plan and By-Law Amendments.

While the West Don Lands has been excluded from the King Parliament Secondary Plan catchment by provincial fiat, we are adjacent to the Secondary Plan area, and planning policy, decisions and precedents from both areas affect the each other.

The work of City Planning staff on this matter are informed by and reflect thorough and responsive consultation with the affected communities. The Secondary Plan review has taken into account local knowledge and needs with regard to built form, public realm, cultural enhancement and preservation, and community and economic development.


We urge you to adopt the report noted above.
