TE25.10 Intention to designate Part IV, Section 29-Ontario Heritage Act- 103 Heath West (Ward 12)

The Deer Park Residents Group (DPRG) supports approval of the recommendations of the report.

103 Heath and the property to the east is subject of a Committee of Adjustment and a site plan application. It is critical that the special features of 103 be protected.

The City of Toronto has a significant history and has some of the largest collections of Victorian houses in North America. 103 Heath was built at a time when Victorian-style houses dominated a number of the City's older neighbourhoods. It has several unique features including the bay-and gable-style.

Heath has a number of such Victorian houses. Preserving the unique James Hobbs House (1892) like another great Victorian at 55 Heath West (1896) is important for our heritage and history.
