The total contract award identified in this report is \$7,231,824 net of all applicable taxes and charges, \$8,171,962 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$7,359,104 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$7,231,825 net of all taxes and charges.
