Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2026.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$6,031,729 net of applicable taxes, \$6,815,854 including HST and all applicable charges. The cost to the City is \$6,137,888 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$6,089,599 net of all applicable taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2022 Approved Capital Budget and the 2023-2031 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows.
