Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2023.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$6,263,092 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$5,640,108 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$ 4,701,996.23 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2022 Approved Capital Budget and 2023-2031 Approved Capital Plan for Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized as follows:
