22-020 2022 Operating Budget – City Staff Recommended

Howard Balter, Manager, Budget and Financial Reporting, reviewed the highlights of the report. Mr. Balter also provided additional information regarding recent public health directives relating to the implementation of rapid antigen testing for staff who delivery essential library service in branches, and the cost of these tests of approximately \$0.5 million per month which is not included in the 2022 Operating Budget.
