HL32.3 - Actions to Respond to the Drug Poisoning Crisis in Toronto

At its December 6th meeting, the Toronto Board of Health adopted recommendations urging the provincial and federal governments to immediately scale-up critical life-saving programs including evidence-informed treatment, supervised consumption services, as well as develop a national framework to permit the simple possession of all drugs for personal use.

At its June 14, 2021 meeting, the Toronto Board of Health adopted this report with amendments and reiterated its call urging the Federal Minister of Health to use the authority under the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act to permit the simple possession of all drugs for personal use.
