Re: EX31.13 - Removal of Harbour Lead Line and Keating Rail Yard (Ward 14)

St. Marys Cement/CBM Ready Mix's production of cement and concrete has helped build Toronto. There are 5 Toronto plants currently in operation. Our Portlands plant is located in the Concrete Campus of the Toronto Portlands where we have been operating since 2006.

Contrary to the staff report, St. Marys/CBM was not consulted about the removal of rail service and asks that this issue be part of the consultations for Port users soon to be started by the Waterfront Secretariat.

While we do not have a current need for rail at our Portlands location, it would be short-sighted to remove the rail and the possibility to restoring service. St. Marys does make use of rail at other locations.
