

# **Parking Amendments - Marine Parade Drive**

#### SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Marine Parade Drive, City Council approval of this report is required.

Transportation Services is recommending that the existing parking prohibitions on the west/south side of Marine Parade Drive be changed to a stopping prohibition. The proposed amendment will deter parking at this location and will improve transit operations and vehicle movements by maintaining a clear passage for TTC vehicles.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times, on the west/south side of Marine Parade Drive, between Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 278 metres east.

2. City Council prohibit stopping at all times, on the west/south side of Marine Parade Drive, between Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 278 metres east.

## FINANCIAL IMPACT

The signage costs associated with the proposed amendments are approximately \$1000.00. Funding is available within the Transportation Services 2022 Operating Budget.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

This report addresses a new initiative.

# COMMENTS

The Ward Councillor, on behalf of a local community association in the Humber Bay Shores neighbourhood, requested that stopping be prohibited at all times on the west/south side of Marine Parade Drive between Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 278 metres east, in order to ensure that parked vehicles do not impede TTC vehicles that use this route.

# **Existing Conditions**

Marine Parade Drive is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, collector roadway
- It operates two-way traffic with raised centre medians and pavement width of approximately 7 metres, in each direction
- The daily two-way traffic volume is approximately 10,000 vehicles
- The speed limit is 40 km/h
- Heavy trucks are prohibited at all times
- There is TTC service provided by the 66, 145 and 176 bus
- There are sidewalks located on both sides of the street.

The parking regulations on Marine Parade Drive, within the subject section are as follows:

#### East/north side

 No stopping anytime, Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 87 metres east of The Marginal Boulevard

#### West/south side

- No parking anytime, Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 278 metres east
- Pay and Display, a point 278 metres south/east of Lake Shore Boulevard West (west intersection) and a point 88 metres south of Lake Shore Boulevard West (east intersection), 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Mon. to Sat.; 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Sun

## **Proposed Changes**

The existing parking prohibition on the west/south side of Marine Parade Drive be replaced with a no stopping prohibition. The proposed amendment will deter illegal parking at this location and will improve transit operations and vehicle movements by maintaining a clear passage.

A map of the area and proposed parking amendment(s) is included in Attachment 1.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation(s) of this staff report.
