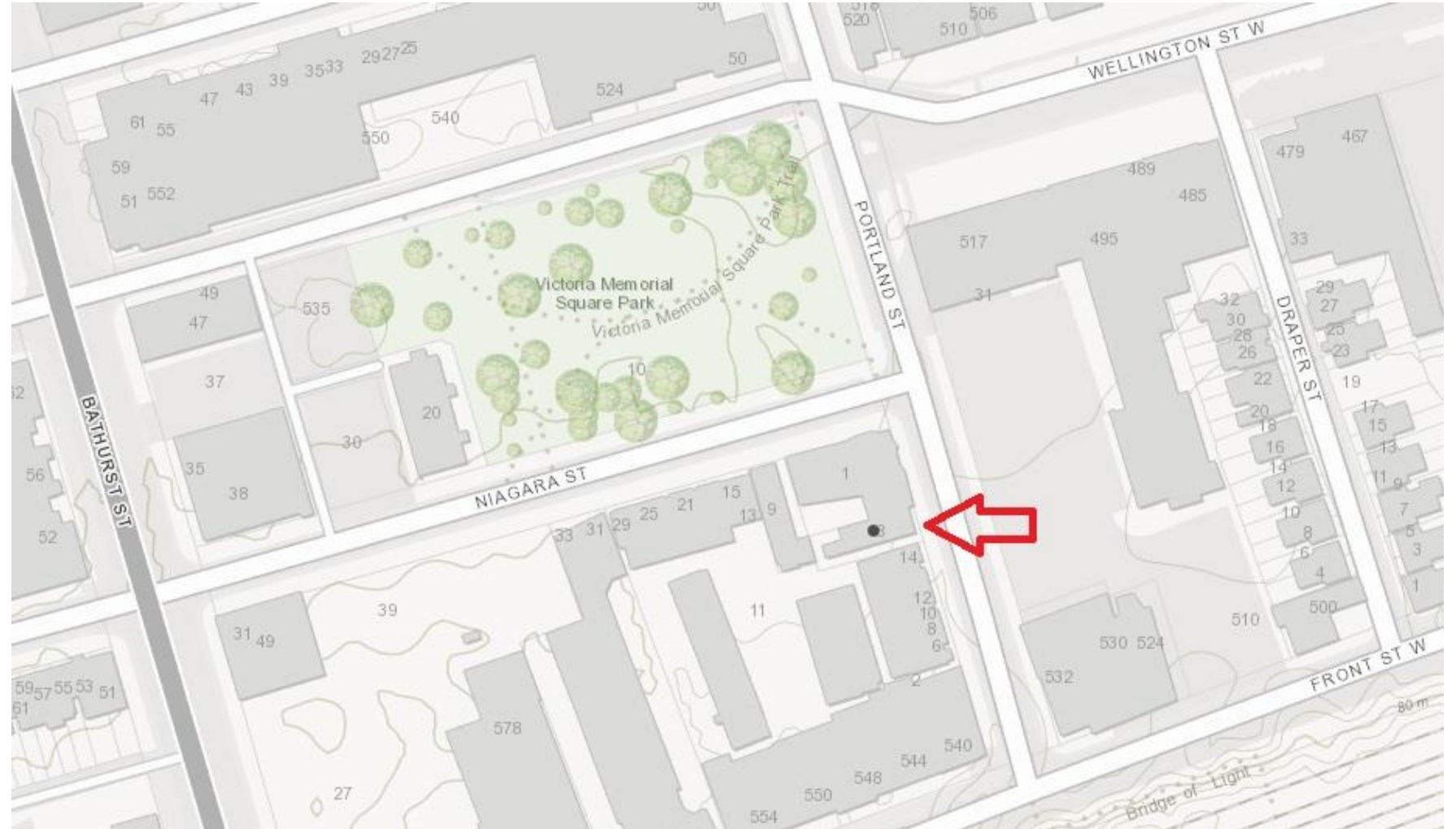

This location map is for information purposes only; the exact boundaries of the property are not shown. The arrow marks the location of the site.

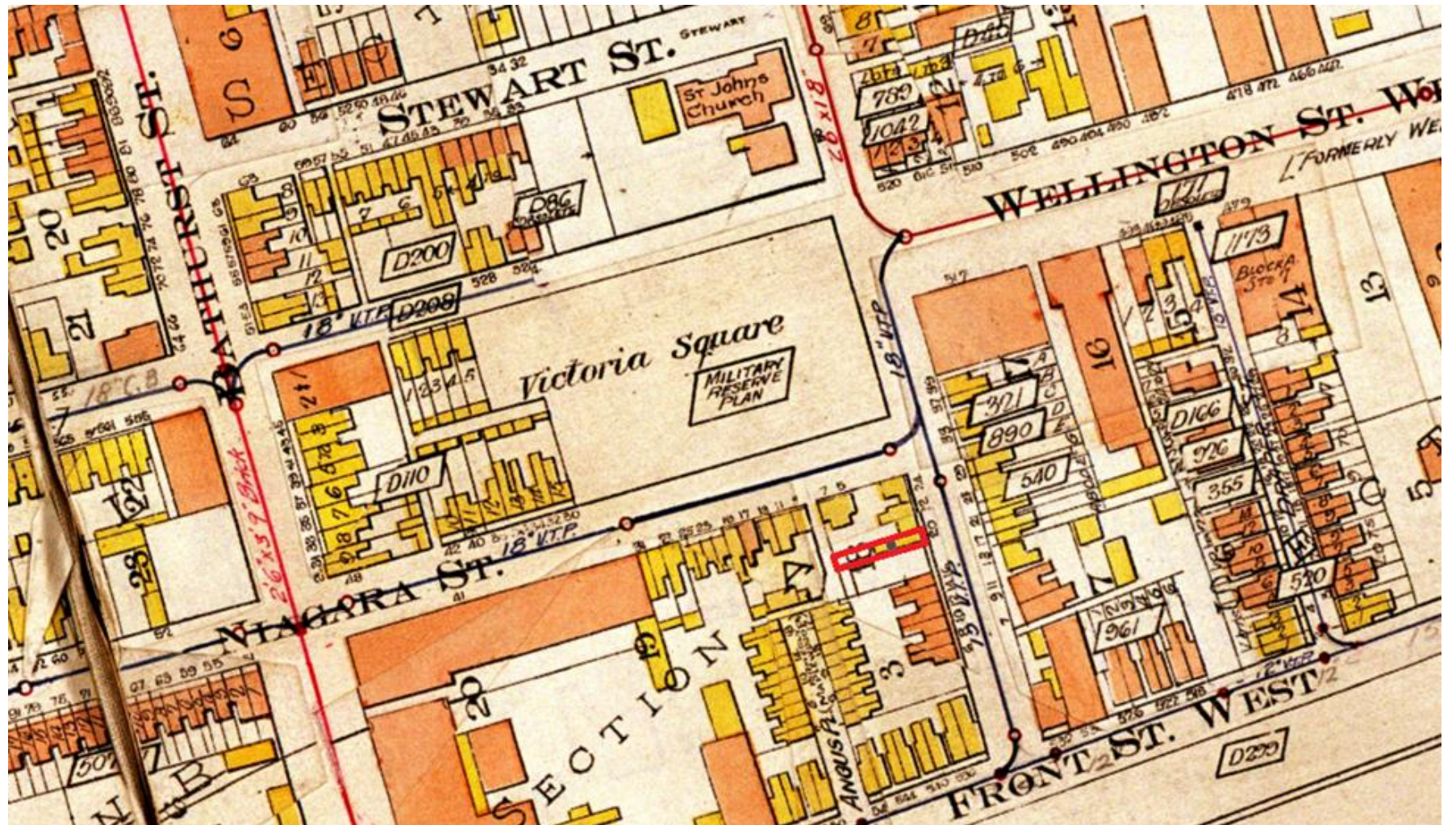

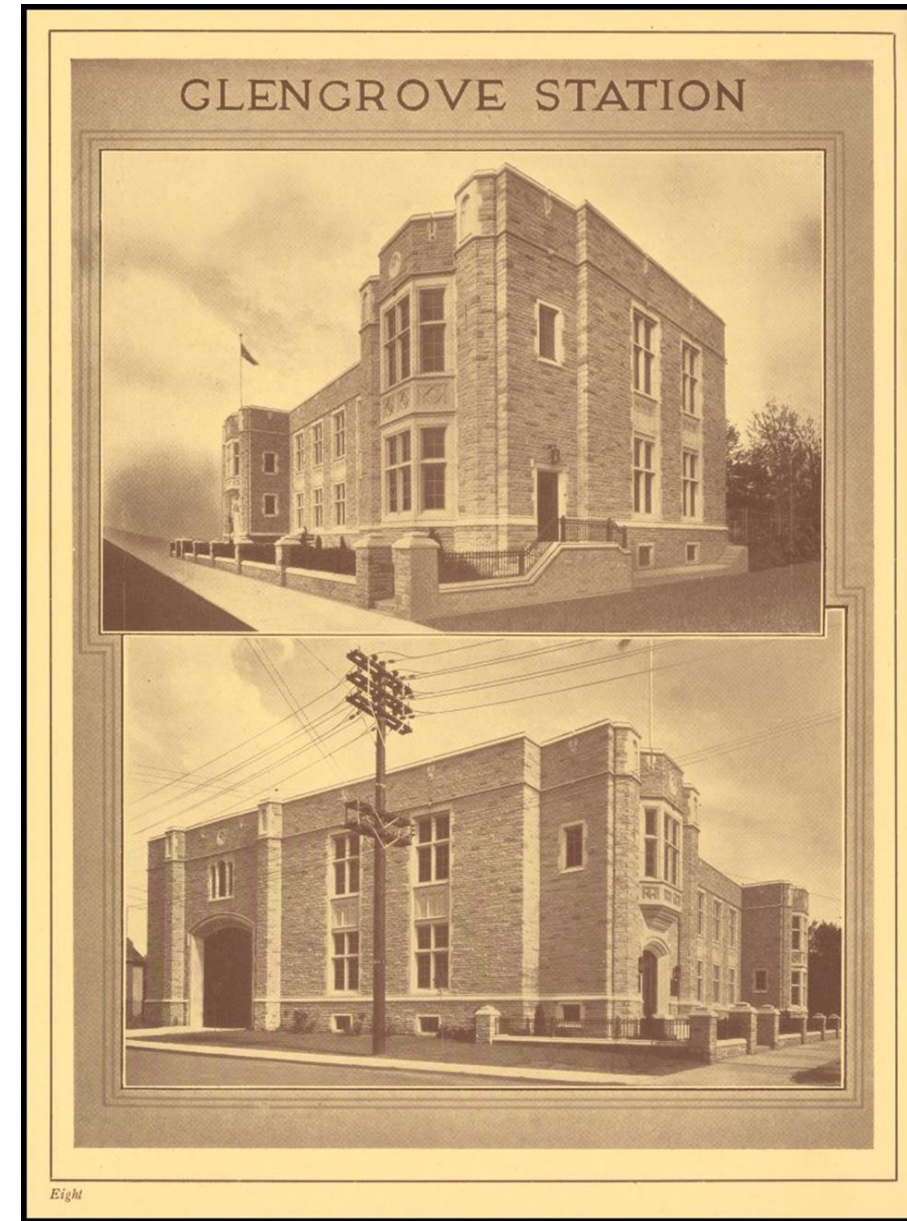
