PB30.2: 1909 and 1913 Yonge Street - Notice of Intention to Designate Properties under Part IV, Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act

The South Eglinton Ratepayers and Residents Association (SERRA) area is bounded by Yonge Street, Eglinton Avenue, Bayview Avenue, and Merton Street. The subject properties identified above are located along our western boundary.

SERRA supports the designation of 1909 Yonge Street and 1913 Yonge Street under Part IV, Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act.

These properties are significant for their connections to the Davis family, early founders of the Davisville Village area. These storefront buildings have housed a multitude of businesses important to the commercial history of Yonge Street and Davisville Avenue.
