Steve Fonyo by Toronto City Council***

The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Steve Fonyo on Friday, February 18, 2022 at the age of 56.

Steve Fonyo is best remembered by Canadians across this country as having ran a nation-wide marathon in 1985 with a prosthetic leg as part of the "Journey for Lives" initiative - following in the footsteps of Terry Fox. His efforts resulted in more than \$13 million being put forth for cancer research.

Within that same year at the age of 19, Steve Fonyo was recognized as an officer of the Order of Canada - making him the youngest person at the time allotted with the achievement. He filled rooms with an encompassing personality, loved and was loved by many. Steve Fonyo's legacy is honoured and celebrated by family, friends and Canadians coast-to-coast.
