

***Expression of Condolence for
Peter Moor Macintyre by Toronto City Council***

The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the passing of Peter Moor Macintyre on Thursday, February 24, 2022, at the age of 70.

Peter retired from the City of Toronto in 2011 as a Commander with Toronto Paramedic Services, capping a 30-plus year career in paramedicine. He started his career as a Paramedic, later certified as an Advanced Care Paramedic, and was soon promoted to District Supervisor and Manager at Toronto Paramedic Services. He spent almost a decade as the Manager of Training for Toronto Paramedic Services and was responsible for training many of Toronto's front-line paramedics. He also served as the communications spokesperson for Toronto Paramedic Services. While working for Toronto Paramedic Services, Peter was also the recipient of the Service Chief's Award for exemplary service to the City of Toronto's Paramedic Services. Peter was a pioneer in paramedicine and his contributions will never be forgotten.

Peter became an Instructor for the Advanced Trauma Life Support program and was later recruited to be the Canadian representative on the board of the International Trauma Life Support organization, serving in several capacities including Director and Treasurer.

Peter had an incredible quick wit, an extraordinary command of the English language and the ability to recount humorous stories which made him an entertaining and engaging conversationalist. He had a profound knowledge of all forms of music with a special love for the Blues and lesser-known artists. He instilled that love of music and his quick humour in his nieces and nephews who looked up to "Uncle Peter" as a second father. He was a frequent cheerleader at his nieces' and nephews' sporting events, concerts and graduations demonstrating his love and commitment to them. His love for his extended family was nurtured with special times at their cottage on Nine Mile Lake, and family expeditions to Europe and the Caribbean. Peter will be sorely missed by Sandra, his wife and best friend of 40 years, his family, friends and colleagues.
