Antonio Congiusti was a successful, enthusiastic member of the Transportation Services team, who had a bright career ahead of him at the City of Toronto.

On March 19th, while heading down to Florida to see the Toronto Blue Jays in spring training, Antonio Congiusti was tragically struck from behind by a tractor trailer and later succumbed to his injuries. The 34-year-old loved the Blue Jays and was an avid baseball player himself, along with many other sports.

Antonio started working for the City of Toronto on April 30, 2014 in the Parks, Forestry and Recreation Division. He moved on to Transportation Services as an Asphalt Concrete Worker 2 and was promoted to an Asphalt Concrete Worker 1 through his hard work and congenial attitude. With his great potential and commitment to continuous improvement, Antonio was promoted to the position of Cut Examiner through the GROW program. He was in this position for two terms. Antonio was an important member of the team at Castlefield Yard and will be missed greatly by his colleagues.
