On submitting a complain into the City on behalf of my elderly parent who leave next door to the above address listed in the subject. I have requested that City Inspector come to site and take a look.

Our neighbours about 5-10 years ago torn down the existing retaining wall & fence and build and paid for the retaining wall shown in the attached photos.


We had a discussion with owners of the house that the construction of the wall was not being built properly and they refused to alter the way the contractor was constructing the retaining wall.

Over time you can see that the soil has started to cause the retaining wall and fence to move and tilt. The posts of the fence are every +/- 4'-0" and were incorporated into the construction of the retaining wall.

This past summer in 2020 they approached my parents that they wanted to possible sell their home and hence wanted to tear down the fence and build it +/- a foot in their yard. We told them you should look at fixing the retaining wall as well as the post are part of the construction of the wall. They told us that the will cut the post and leave it as is and cosmetically from their yard everything looks good but any new buyers will not be aware of the issues.

As of November 16th they had a contactor start to tear down the fence and I have now reached out to City for help.
