

Refusal of a Clothing Drop Box Location permit application located at 2 Regal Road

SUMMARY

The purpose of this staff report is to report on the refusal to issue a permit by Municipal Licensing & Standards in the matter of an application for a Clothing Drop Box Location permit at 2 Regal Road.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director of Business Licensing and Regulatory Services, Municipal Licensing & Standards recommends that:

1. City Council deny the application for the proposed Clothing Drop Box Location permit at 2 Regal Road.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

DECISION HISTORY

This is a new application for a clothing drop box permit located at 2 Regal Road.

COMMENTS

An application for clothing drop box permit privileges at 85 Emmett Avenue was received on October 15, 2021 from the business owner representing B'nai Brith National Organization of Canada operating as B'nai Brith National Organization of Canada. The application submitted was seeking permission to place/install at the subject location. (Appendix No. 1 and 2)

This application meets the physical criteria for a clothing drop box location permit, as set out in Chapter 395 of the City of Toronto Municipal Code.

The City of Toronto Municipal Code, Chapter 395-2, Subsection B.(1)(a) states: Where a written objection is received by the Executive Director within the fourteen day period in Subsection B(1)(a), the Executive Director shall refuse the application, notify the applicant of the refusal of the application and advise the applicant that the applicant may, within 30 days of the date of the refusal, appeal the refusal to the Executive Director in writing.

An objection from the Ward Councillor was received by Municipal Licensing & Standards on November 4, 2021.

A refusal letter was sent on November 4, 2021 to the business owner, advising the applicant that an objection was received and that the clothing drop box location permit application was denied.

On November 10, 2021 a letter was received by Municipal Licensing & Standards from the business owner, to appeal the decision of the denial for a clothing drop box location permit.
