

Car-Share Vehicle Parking Areas – Various Locations

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is requesting authorization to rescind car-share vehicle parking areas (CVPAs) at various locations in the Toronto and East York Community Council area.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the amendments to parking regulations set out in Attachment 2, attached to the report entitled "Car-Share Vehicle Parking Areas - Various Locations", dated January 31, 2022 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with the necessary signage installation are included within the Transportation Services 2022 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

At its previous meetings, Toronto and East York Community Council authorized the installation of car-share vehicle parking areas (CVPAs) for Zipcar at various locations, including Canniff Street, Fraser Avenue, Irwin Avenue and Bastedo Avenue. 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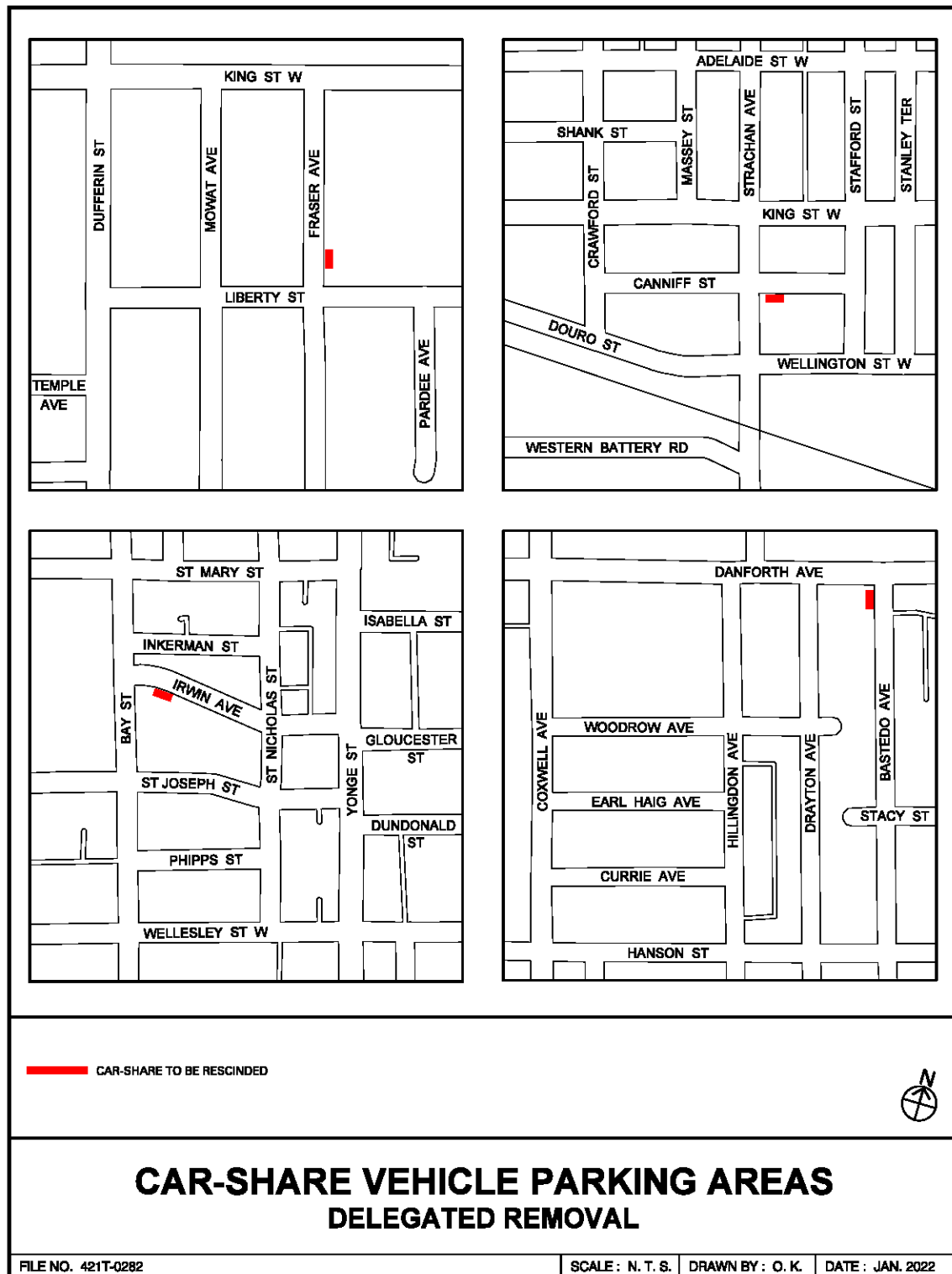

Attachment 2: Amendments to Parking Regulations

1. Rescind the car-share vehicle parking area for up to two Zipcar vehicles on the east side of Fraser Avenue, between a point 21.4 metres north of Liberty Street and a point 11 metres further north.
2. Amend the existing parking machine regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday and 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the east side of Fraser Avenue, between a point 32.4 metres north of Liberty Street and a point 18.8 metres south of King Street West, to be in effect between a point 21.4 metres north of Liberty Street and a point 18.8 metres south of King Street West.
3. Rescind the car-share vehicle parking area for up to two Zipcar vehicles on the south side of Canniff Street, between a point 9.6 metres east of Strachan Avenue and a point 11 metres further east.
4. Amend the existing parking machine regulation in effect from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday and 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., Sunday, on the south side of Canniff Street, between a point 20.6 metres east of Strachan Avenue and Stafford Street, to be in effect between Strachan Avenue and Stafford Street.
5. Rescind the car-share vehicle parking area for up to two Zipcar vehicles on the south side of Irwin Avenue, between a point 24 metres east of Bay Street and a point 11 metres further east.
6. Rescind the car-share vehicle parking area for up to two Zipcar vehicles on the west side of Bastedo Avenue, between a point 9 metres south of Danforth Avenue and a point 11 metres further south.
7. Amend the existing Permit Parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the even (west) side of Bastedo Avenue, from Stacy Street to Danforth Avenue at all times, except no parking anytime between a point 9 metres south of Danforth Avenue and a point 11 metres further south to be in effect at all times.
8. Amend the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Saturday, in effect on the west side of Bastedo Avenue, between Stacy Street and a point 20 metres south of Danforth Avenue, to be in effect between Stacy Street and Danforth Avenue.
