Subject: Amendments to the existing parking regulation on Parkdale Road at Glendale Avenue

SUMMARY

The intersection of Parkdale Road and Glendale Avenue is located in the Sunnyside neighbourhood in Ward 4. During a neighbourhood walk with residents, it was noted that a vehicle could be park in the intersection of Parkdale Road and Glendale Avenue due to current parking regulations.

Transportation Staff did a review of the intersection and recommend changes to the parking regulation to improve the safety and visibility of the intersection.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing maximum one-hour parking regulation in effect from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on both sides of Parkdale Road, between Indian Road and Glendale Avenue (south intersection)
2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the south side of Parkdale Road, between Indian Road and Glendale Avenue (south intersection)
3. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking for a maximum period of one hour from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on the north side of Parkdale Road, between Indian Road and a point 160 metres east
4. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the north side of Parkdale Road from a point 160 metres east of Indian Road to a point 24.8 metres further east.
