

Parking Amendments – Munro Street, Matilda Street and Sammon Avenue

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The purpose of this report is to resolve by-law amendments missed in Item TE11.35 "Residential On-street Permit Parking - Status Update on the Expansion of On-Street Permit Parking in the Toronto and East York Community Council Area".

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking be introduced on Munro Street, between Dundas Street East and Matilda Avenue/Kintyre Avenue from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily and to move permit parking on Sammon Avenue, from the odd to even side of the street. These proposed by-law amendments will ensure that the intent of Item TE11.35, as adopted with amendments by City Council on January 29, 2020 can be properly installed and enforced.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking by permit only on an area name basis, within permit parking area 7F, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on odd side of Munro Street, between Dundas Street East and Thompson Street.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking by permit only on an area name basis, within permit parking area 7F, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on odd side of Matilda Street, between Munro Street and Davies Avenue.

3. Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing permit parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily on the odd side of Sammon Avenue, between Pape Avenue to Woodycrest Avenue, to be in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily on the even side of Sammon Avenue, from Pape Avenue to Woodycrest Avenue.

4. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the south side of Sammon Avenue, between Pape Avenue and Woodycrest Avenue.

5. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing permit parking regulation in effect from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., daily on the odd side of Sammon Avenue, between Woodycrest Avenue and Dewhurst Boulevard North.

6. Toronto and East York Community Council prohibit parking at all times on the south side of Sammon Avenue, between Woodycrest Avenue and Dewhurst Boulevard North.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated funding to implement the parking regulations is \$800 which is available within Transportation Services 2022 Operating Budget. The maximum annual revenue that could potentially be generated if all parking spaces are occupied by a permit holder is \$7,000.00

DECISION HISTORY

On January 29, 2020, City Council adopted Item TE11.35 entitled "Residential On-street Permit Parking - Status Update on the Expansion of On-Street Permit Parking in the Toronto and East York Community Council Area" with amendments, and in so doing, authorized the expansion of permit parking in Wards 4, 9 and 14.

COMMENTS

Through many variables such as the ward boundary realignment, the scope of the Permit Parking Expansion project and reduction of staff resources due to Covid-19, some parking regulations were omitted from Item TE11.35. These regulations include missed blocks requiring the implementation of permit parking and parking prohibitions.

The approval of the parking regulations on Munro Street, Matilda Avenue and Sammon Avenue will resolve discrepancies in City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapters 925 and 950 to align with the recommendations previously approved by City Council for item TE11.35 regarding Wards 4, 9 and 14.

Maps of Munro Street, Matilda Avenue and Sammon Avenue are included in Attachments 1, 2 and 3.

The Ward Councillors have been advised of the recommendations in this report.

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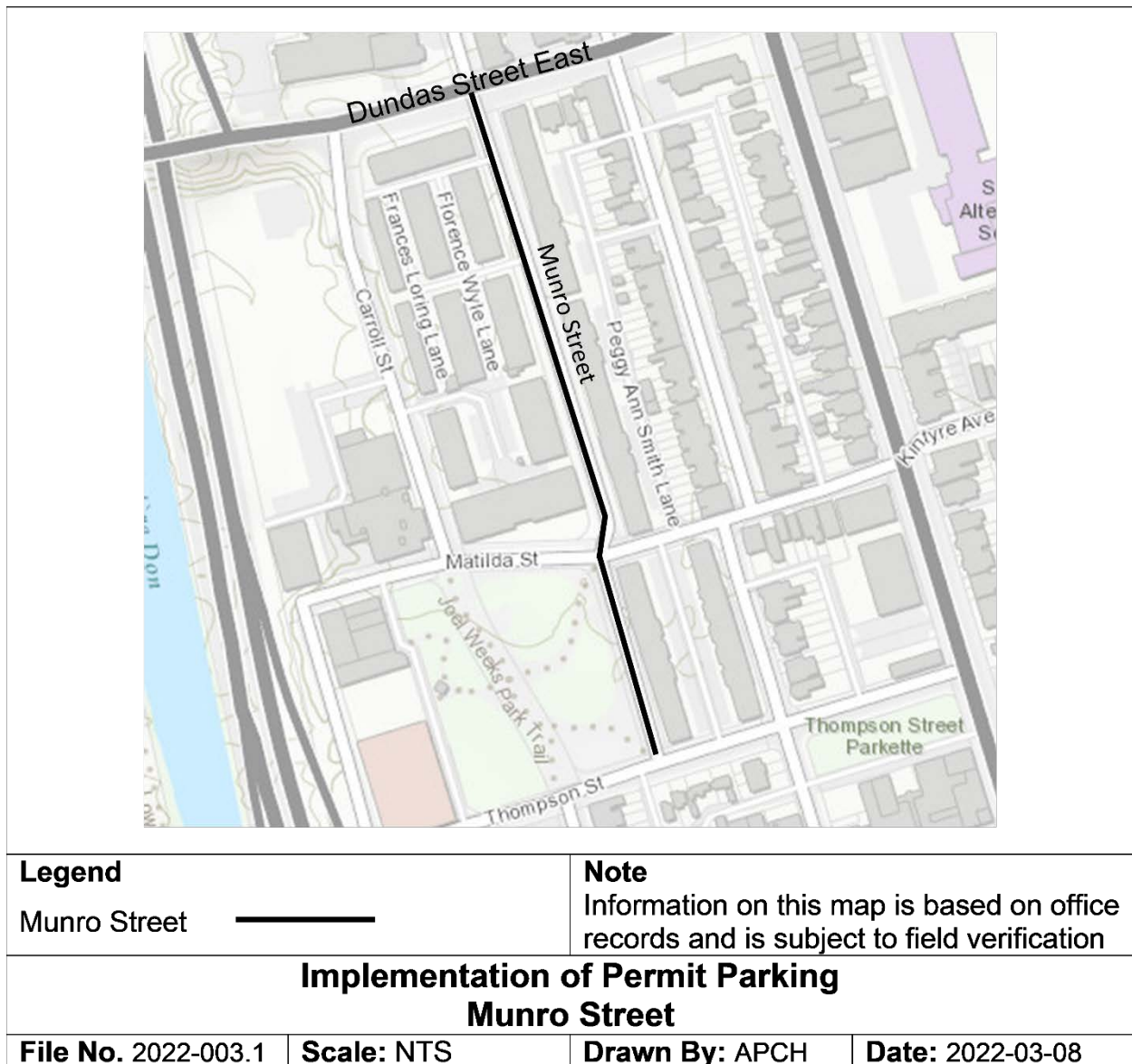
