Blake Street Parking Amendments

Dear Chair and Members of the Toronto and East York Community Council,

The Jones Avenue Jewish Cemetery is one of the oldest in the city, with some plots dating to 1885. Their access for vehicles is off Blake Avenue. They have contacted my office about the habitual blocking of their driveway by vehicles. Transportation Services has prepared language to modify the existing No-Parking area to cover the cemetery frontage. This change will not impact permit parking.

I look forward to having your support for this.

Recommendation:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council amend the existing parking prohibition in effect at all times on the east side of Blake Street, between Boulton Avenue and a point 318 metres north to be in effect between Boulton Avenue and a point 378 metres north.
2. Toronto and East York Community Council rescind the existing parking prohibition in effect from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on the east side of Blake Street, between a point 347 meters north of Boulton Avenue and a point 11 meters further north.
