# Use of Nathan Phillips Square for Various Events from August 1, 2022 - April 30, 2023

**Date:** May 9, 2022

**To:** Toronto and East York Community Council

#### **SUMMARY**

The purpose of this report is to request various exemptions from the Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 636 "Public Squares" and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 237 "Nathan Phillips Square" for events that are proposed to be held on Nathan Phillips Square, August 1, 2022 - April 30, 2023.

The issuing of permits and exemptions for the events listed in this report will be conditional on adherence to public health regulations. Organizers will be responsible for submitting operational plans to the permit-issuing body, and monitoring on-site operations in a manner that maintains compliance with all public health guidelines and best practices. Staff in the Economic Development and Culture Division, in consultation with Toronto Public Health, will work with event organizers to assess viability, based on ongoing public health direction and the risks associated with specific events.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

The Interim General Manager, Economic Development and Culture recommends that:

- 1. City Council grant an exemption to Better Futures for Kids, Philippines Independence Day Council, Canadian Egyptian Heritage Association, United Way Greater Toronto, Canadian Association of Chinese Performing Arts, Celebrate Toronto, Second Harvest Canada, City Cultural Events, Production, Economic Development and Culture Division, Epilepsy Toronto, to operate a beer garden and to serve wine and hard liquor contingent upon the following conditions:
  - Approval of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario
  - Approval of the Medical Officer of Health
  - Compliance with the City of Toronto's Municipal Alcohol Policy
  - Receipt of all the necessary permits associated with the production of the event i.e. building permit, noise by-law extension permit

City Council grant permission to Better Futures for Kids, Hiroshima /Nagasaki Day Coalition, Panorama India, United Way Greater Toronto, Moksha Canada Foundation, Canadian Association of Chinese Performing Arts, Strategic Partnerships, City Manager's Office, City Cultural Events, Production, Economic Development and Culture Division, Toronto Council Fire Native Cultural Centre, Epilepsy Toronto, Fast in the 6, to use open flame as part of their event production.
- 7. City Council grant permission to City Cultural Events, Production, Economic Development and Culture, Fast in the 6, to use special effects pyrotechnics as part of their event production.
- 8. City Council grant permission to City Cultural Events, Production, Economic Development and Culture Division, to cover City Hall windows and building as part of their event production.
- 9. City Council require that the various events compensate the City of Toronto, through the Facilities Management Division, for all City of Toronto costs associated with an event above the standard staffing compliment.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The City of Toronto will be compensated by the event organizers for any costs incurred by the City as a result of these various events and the approval of requested exemptions. There are no additional funding requirements associated with this initiative in current and future years.

The Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer has reviewed this report and agrees with the information as presented in the Financial Impact Section.

#### COMMENTS

The Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 636 "Public Squares" and former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 237 "Nathan Phillips Square" prohibits the solicitation of donations, the sale of alcohol, placing objects in the reflecting pool, use of open flame and special effects pyrotechnics, amplification of sound outside of NPS amplification schedule policy, "gated or ticketed" events and engagement in sport demonstrations and covering of City Hall windows and building on Nathan Phillips Square without the approval of Council.

Various event organizers are requesting permission to solicit donations, engage in sports demonstrations, amplify sound outside of NPS amplification schedule policy, use of open flame as part of their event production, operate beer/wine garden, place objects in the pool, use special effects pyrotechnics and permission to cover City Hall windows and building. The proceeds of these and other sales will go to their respective non-profit organizations.
