

Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations for 2022 Canadian National Exhibition (Delegated)

To: Toronto and East York Community Council

SUMMARY

This staff report concerns a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision. The temporary parking amendments recommended are required to enhance traffic operations and pedestrian safety during this year's Canadian National Exhibition (CNE), which takes place from August 19 to September 05, 2022, inclusive.

A companion report, "Temporary Adjustments to Traffic and Parking Regulations for 2022 Canadian National Exhibition (Non-Delegated)", dated June 13, 2022, outlines the required non-delegated temporary traffic and parking amendments for locations with Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) service.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services, recommends that:

1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize the temporary parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Exhibition Place that are impacted during the CNE, identified in Attachment 2 attached to the report "Temporary Adjustment to Parking Regulations for 2022 Canadian National Exhibition (Delegated)", dated June 13, 2022, from the Director, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

Funds in the amount of \$3,000.00 are available within the Transportation Services Division's 2022 Capital Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

Annually, the Transportation Services Division requests Community and City Council authority to implement a number of temporary traffic and parking regulations on various streets in the vicinity of Exhibition Place that are impacted by the CNE.

COMMENTS

Having regard for the high volume of vehicular and pedestrian traffic generated during this annual event, the temporary parking regulations as shown in the attached Attachment 2 will help maintain efficient traffic conditions in the general area of the CNE while recognizing the impacts on local residents. None of the streets listed in Attachment 2 have regular TTC routes. The temporary traffic and parking amendments include No Standing on Thornburn Avenue northside between Dufferin Street and Tyndall Avenue; No Standing on Temple Ave north side between Dufferin Street and Tyndall Avenue; No Standing on Tyndall Avenue between Springhurst Avenue and King Street; 24Hour Permit Parking on streets from Melbourne Avenue to Springhurst Avenue and Dunn Avenue to Tyndall Avenue/Gwynne AvenueIt is noted that a companion report is also submitted relating to temporary traffic and parking adjustments for the 2022 CNE for streets served by transit routes and requiring City Council approval.
