

## **Temporary Adjustments to Traffic and Parking Regulations for 2022 Distillery Winter Village (Non-delegated)**

### **SUMMARY**

---

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on Parliament Street, Mill Street and Front Street East, City Council approval of this report is required.

The purpose of this report is to seek City Council's authority to enact temporary traffic and parking amendments required to enhance traffic operations and pedestrian safety during the annual Distillery Winter Village, which takes place from November 17, 2022 to December 31, 2022, inclusive.

A companion report, "Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations for 2022 Distillery Winter Village (Delegated)" outlines the required delegated temporary parking amendments for locations without TTC Service.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

1. City Council authorize the temporary traffic and parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Distillery District that are impacted during the Distillery Winter Village, identified in Attachment 2 attached to the report dated June 13, 2022 from the Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services, subject to Toronto and East York Community Council adoption of the companion report entitled, "Temporary Adjustments to Parking Regulations for 2022 Distillery Winter Village (Delegated)". The temporary parking regulations will override all existing regulations for the duration of this event (November 17, 2022 to December 31, 2022).

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

The event organizers will be responsible for the full costs associated with the Distillery Winter Village event. There are no direct budgetary implications to the City.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

---

Toronto and East York Community Council at its meeting of November 24, 2021, by adoption of TE29.81 authorized the temporary parking regulations on streets in the vicinity of Distillery District that are impacted during the Distillery Winter Village.

## **COMMENTS**

---

Having regard for the high volume of vehicular and pedestrian traffic generated during the Distillery Winter Village, the temporary traffic and parking regulations as shown in Attachment 2 remains the same as 2021 and will help maintain efficient traffic conditions in the general area of the Distillery District while recognizing the impacts on the local residents. A map of the affected streets is shown in Attachment 1. It is noted that a companion report is also submitted relating the temporary parking adjustments for the 2022 Distillery Winter Village for streets not served by transit routes.

Upon completion of the event, Transportation Services staff, in consultation with the local Councillors, the event organizers and other stakeholders will evaluate the traffic management plan. In this regard amendments to the traffic management plan may be implemented for the following year.

The local Ward Councillors have been advised of the recommendations of this staff report.

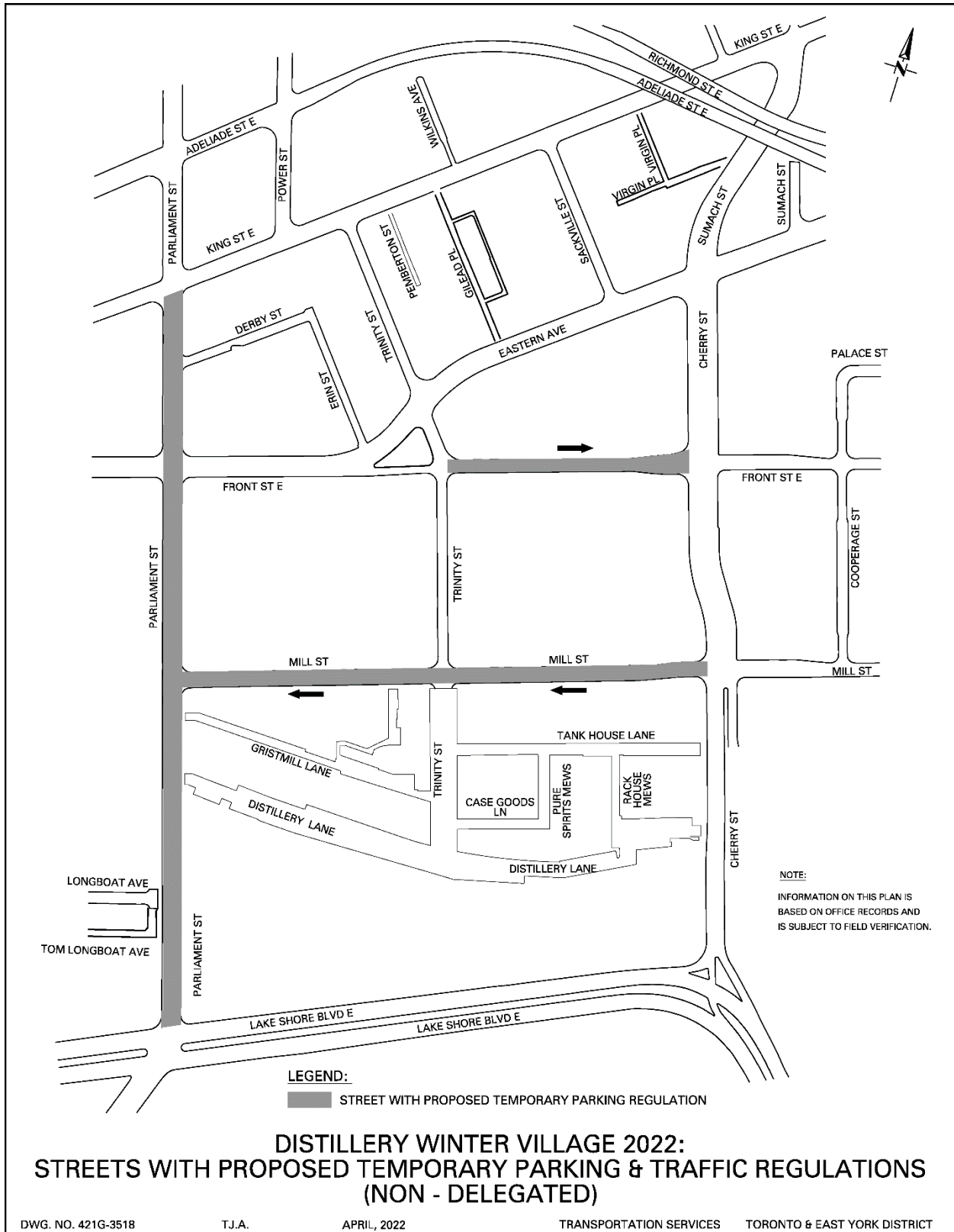

Highway	Side	Between	Prohibited Times of Days
Parliament Street	Both	King Street East and Lake Shore Boulevard East	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Front Street East	North	Trinity Street and Cherry Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Mill Street	South	Parliament Street and a point 90 metres east	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Mill Street	South	A point 101 metres east of Parliament Street and Trinity Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
Mill Street	North	A point 61 metres east of Trinity Street and a point 122 metres east of Trinity Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022

Highway	Side	Location	Times and/or Days
Front Street East	South	Between Trinity Street and a point 70 metres west of Cherry Street	Anytime from and including Thurs. Nov. 17, 2022 to and including Sat. Dec. 31, 2022
