**RE: Speed Hump Installation on Ennerdale Road** 

## **BACKGROUND:**

In September 2021, residents reached out to my office with an urgent concern about speeding along their street and requested via an online survey that traffic calming measures (speed humps) be installed as a method of addressing these concerns. Unanimously, the residents that responded were in support of making this change.

I am requesting that speed humps be installed on Ennerdale Road from Eglinton Avenue West to the intersection of Branstone and Dynevor Road.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 1. Waive the polling requirement under the City's Traffic Calming Policy and authorize the installation of traffic calming (speed humps) on Ennerdale Road, between Eglinton Avenue West and Dynevor Road.
- 2. Direct the City Solicitor to prepare a by-law to alter sections of the roadway on Ennerdale Road, between Eglinton Avenue West and Dynevor Road, to install three speed humps, generally as shown on the copy of - 'Drawing No. 421G-4102' dated June 2022 from the Director, Traffic Management, Transportation Services.
