Introduction of Overnight On-Street Permit Parking - Heath Street East

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter that Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

Transportation Services is recommending that overnight on-street permit parking be introduced on Heath Street East, between Mount Pleasant Road and Welland Avenue from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., on a street name basis.

Residents requested the implementation of overnight on-street permit parking on Heath Street East to accommodate their long-term parking needs.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Permits and Enforcement, Transportation Services recommends that:

- 1. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking by permit only, on a street name basis, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the odd side of Heath Street East, between Mount Pleasant Road and Welland Avenue.
- 2. Toronto and East York Community Council authorize parking by permit only, on a street name basis, from 12:01 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. daily on the even side of Heath Street East, between Kingsmere Road and Welland Avenue.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The estimated funding to implement permit parking is \$1,200 which is available within Transportation Services 2022 Operating Budget. The maximum annual revenue that could potentially be generated if all parking spaces are occupied by a permit holder is \$10,580.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

A request was received from the Ward Councillor, on behalf of area residents, to introduce the overnight on-street permit parking program on Heath Street East, between Mount Pleasant Road and Welland Avenue to accommodate their long-term parking needs without being subject to tagging by Toronto Police Service, Parking Enforcement Unit.

Existing Conditions

Heath Street East, between Mount Pleasant Road and Welland Avenue is characterized by the following conditions:

- It is a two-lane, east-west local roadway
- It operates two-way traffic on a pavement width of approximately 8.7 metres
- Speed limit 30 km/h
- There is no TTC service.

The parking regulations on Heath Street East, within the subject section are as follows:

North side

Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

South side

Maximum of three-hour parking at all times.

Polling Results

In accordance with Municipal Code Chapter 925 a poll was conducted to determine if there is support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking. Ballots were mailed out on May 9, 2022 to all residents on Heath Street East with the last day for filing a response being June 7, 2022. A poll will be considered valid when at least 25 percent of the ballots mailed have been returned to the City Clerk. In order for a poll to be deemed positive 50 percent plus one of returned ballots must be in favour of the request. For Heath Street East 48 ballots were returned which represents a response rate of 41 percent. Table 1 summarizes the level of support for the installation of overnight on-street permit parking.

Table 1: Poll Results - Support for Permit Parking - Cambrai Avenue

Response Type	Number of ballots	Percentage
In Favour	26	54%
Opposed	19	36%
Spoiled Ballot	0	0%

As the majority of the ballots returned were in favour of implementing permit parking and the required minimum response rate was met, the poll was deemed to be positive.

The Ward Councillor has been advised of the recommendation in this report.
