# **Description:**

Provide Landscape Architectural Professional and Technical Services to design and administer construction of two new parks at 10 Ordnance Street and 801 Wellington Street West during the contract term of 2023 to 2025.

# **Recommended Supplier:**

DTAH

#### **Contract Award Value:**

\$724,537 net of all applicable taxes and charges \$818,727 including HST and all applicable charges \$737,289 net of HST recoveries Contract is expected to start following the date of award and end by December 31, 2025.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total potential contract award identified in this report is \$818,727 including all applicable taxes and charges. The total potential cost to the City is \$737,289 net of HST recoveries.

The Architectural estimate for this project is \$825,000 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding for this project is included in the 2023 Approved Capital Budgets and 2024-2032 Capital Plans for Parks, Forestry, and Recreation and Waterfront Revitalization Initiative as summarized in Table 1.
