Contract is expected to start on date of award and end on December 31, 2025.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$16,815,870 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$15,143,211 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$13,233,785 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is available in the 2023 Approved Capital Budget and 2024-2032 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows:
