FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$19,707,528 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the city is \$17,747,239 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$19,034,397 net of all taxes and charges

Funding is included in the 2023 Approved Capital Budget and 2024-2032 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water and Transportation Services. Funding details are summarized in table 1.
