FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$5,737,725 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$5,166,999 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$4,018,244 net of all applicable taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2023 Approved Capital Budget and the 2024-2032 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows.
