FINANCIAL IMPACT

The total contract award identified in this report is \$9,717,956 net of all applicable taxes and charges and \$10,981,290 including all applicable taxes and charges. The cost to the City is \$9,888,992 net of HST recoveries.

The engineering estimate for this project is \$10,308,524 net of all taxes and charges.

Funding is included in the 2023 Approved Capital Budget and 2024-2032 Approved Capital Plan for Toronto Water. Funding details are summarized in Table 1 as follows:
