BY-LAW XXX-2022

To extend the hours of sale of liquor by holders of a licence under the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, by one hour in the morning during the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022

Whereas under subsection 79(1) of the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, the City may pass by-laws extending the hours of sale of liquor in all or part of the City by licensees of a licence to operate liquor consumption premises during events of municipal, provincial, national or international significance; and

Whereas under subsection 79(3) of the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, this by-law does not prevail over a condition of a licence or permit issued under the Act; and

Whereas the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022 will be held from November 20, 2022 to December 18, 2022 with games starting at 5:00 a.m.;

The Council of the City of Toronto enacts:

1. In the City of Toronto from November 25, 2022 to December 18, 2022, both inclusive, liquor may be sold by licensees of a licence to operate liquor consumption premises under the Liquor Licence and Control Act, 2019, beginning at 8:00 a.m.
