

Designation of the King-Spadina Heritage Conservation District under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act - OLT Hearing

SUMMARY

City Council designated the King-Spadina Heritage Conservation District and adopted the King-Spadina Heritage Conservation District Plan (the "King-Spadina HCD") under Part V of the *Ontario Heritage Act* at its meeting of October 2, 2017. The King-Spadina HCD was subsequently appealed to the Ontario Land Tribunal (the "OLT").

The OLT has scheduled a 25 day hearing on the merits of the King-Spadina HCD commencing on January 15, 2024. The City Solicitor requires further direction on the matter.

As permitted by the Tribunal's modified procedural order, on October 13, 2023, the remaining appellants to the King-Spadina HCD filed proposed modifications to the HCD Plan. The City Solicitor is reviewing the proposed modifications with City staff to determine the further direction that may be needed on this litigation matter. It is anticipated that a further report will be submitted for the City Council meeting on November 8, 9 and 10, 2023.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Solicitor recommends that:

1. City Council receive this report for information.
